Family Skate is starting, with Covid-19 safety protocols in place!

Program Details

- **In order to participate, you must pre-sign up. Here is how:**
 - **PHONE: Trail Parks and Recreation at 250-364-0888.**
 - Bookings can be made up to one week in advance.
 - Payment is done at the arena skate shop.
- Space is limited to ensure physical distancing can be maintained on the ice.
- As physical distancing may not always be possible while putting on skates, please come prepared with a mask and plan to wear it if physical distancing cannot be maintained.
- Do a self-assessment at home! If you are feeling unwell or are displaying any Covid-19 symptoms, please stay home.
- This is a FAMILY SKATE. This means a parent must participate on the ice with anyone under the age of 16. Individuals are also welcome!
- One adult can assume responsibility for up to 5 children.
- Spectators are not permitted. Only those participating in the activity are permitted in the facility.
- **SKATE RENTALS ARE NOT AVAILABLE AT THIS TIME.**

If you wish to attend family skating, please remember that you participate at your own risk.

Facility Guidelines

- **Don't arrive early!** – Arrive no more than 10 minutes prior to the start time.
- **Entrance at the Memorial Centre back doors (near Kids Rink).** **Please note:** the facility is not available to the general public. Only those who signed up in advance are permitted.
- **Follow the signage** – 2 m physical distance in effect at all times – on the ice, putting on skates, and when paying admission.
- Staff will assign places to put on skates.
- **Spectators** are not permitted. Only those skating can be in the facility.
- **Leave the facility immediately after the skate.**
