



City of Trail RV Park Guest COVID-19 Code of Conduct – Effective May 1, 2021

Code of Conduct

You and your party agree to abide by this Code of Conduct while at the RV Park.

Quarantine

You are not allowed in the RV Park if you are required to quarantine.

Self-Isolation

No self-isolating is allowed at the RV Park.

Social Distancing

We ask visitors to continue to follow PHO guidelines and practice physical distancing by limiting your camping party to your household/core bubble only. Household groups must maintain 2-metre (6 feet) social distancing from other household groups.

Households/Core Bubble

Households are defined as those people that live in the same residence and have maintained social distancing during the COVID-19 outbreak. For most people, their core bubble is their immediate household. For people who live alone, a core bubble is a maximum of two people you see regularly.

Group

Each group in an RV or tenting site must be from one household unit/core bubble. PHO guidelines for gatherings may change between the time of booking and a scheduled arrival date. Camping parties MUST meet current PHO guidelines for gatherings.

Parental Supervision of Children

Parents must ensure that their children maintain a 2-metre (6 feet) separation at all times from other children/people from other parties during your stay.

Mask Use

All RV Park guests must wear masks when interacting with the Park Attendant and while inside the common washroom facilities (except when showering/brushing teeth). Masks must cover the nose and mouth. Exceptions include children under the age of 2 and people whose medical condition prevents them from wearing a mask.

Wood Purchases

No wood sales will be available at the City of Trail RV Park during the 2021 season. Camp fires are permitted, subject to any Provincial fire bans and restrictions in place.

Returning from Outings

If you leave the property for any reason, everyone in the group must wash their hands with warm water and soap for at least 20 seconds (or disinfectant) upon returning. Please consider washing your grocery and beverage packaging followed by 20 seconds of handwashing.

Irregularities

If you come across someone not maintaining the 2-metre (6 feet) social distancing requirement, please remember that they may be in one household group. If someone infringes on your 2-metre (6 feet) distance, kindly remind them of the 2-metre (6 feet) rule. Please de-escalate any confrontational situations and if needed report the situation to the City of Trail via email.
